The said transfer will be effected from the date of their joining in CGST & Central Excise, Lucknow Zone and will be governed by all the terms and conditions as laid down in the aforesaid Board's letter dated 27.10.2011 alongwith following terms and conditions.

1. If any officer (mentioned above in Table-'A', hereinafter referred as "Transferee"), has been promoted to higher post by their parent Zone, his/her said ICT transfer will only be considered subject to his/her reversion to the post of Tax Assistant in his parent Zone since their ICT applications alongwith NOC have been forwarded in the cadre of Tax Assistant by their respective cadre controlling authorities.
2. The transferee will be placed below all the officers appointed regularly in the Tax Assistant grade on the date of his/her appointment on transfer basis in term of para 3.5 of DOP&Ts O.M. dated 03.07.86. In other words such a transferee will be junior to those regularly appointed officers prior to his/her date of joining in this Zone.
3. The transferee will not be considered for promotion in the Parent Zone.
4. The transferee will not be entitled to any Joining Time and Transfer Travelling Allowance.

5. The transferee is liable to be transferred anywhere within the jurisdiction of CGST & Central Excise, Lucknow/Meerut Zone (under the combined cadre control Lucknow Zone). This order is conditional inter alia to the extent that posting to specific stations may not be possible. Candidates must consider this point before they choose to be relieved from their present postings.
6. Before the relieving of above transferee, Vigilance Clearance & Integrity Certificate (as on date) Bio-data as per Service Book of the individual (duly attested by the concerned DDO), attested copy of "History of Posting", updated ACRs/APARs & IPRs may be sent to this office. If, there is a vigilance case pending/contemplated against the officer concerned then prior to his/her relieving, details must be sent to this office. The Service Book/Personal File of the officers concerned may be sent directly to the parent Commissionerate where they will be posted.
7. The transferee should report to this office immediately after getting relieved from their parent Commissionerate/Zone, but in no case later than **25.03.2020** failing which, the order will be deemed to have been cancelled, ab-initio, with reference to such officer, without any further intimation to officer concerned.
